Emergency Management and Response System (EMRS)

The Emergency Management Response System 2.0 (EMRS2) is a web-based application used for the reporting of routine investigations of foreign animal diseases (FADs), surveillance and control programs, State-specific disease outbreaks, and national animal health emergency responses (all-hazards).

National Preparedness and Incident Coordination

National Preparedness and Incident Coordination develops strategies, policies, tools, and resources to prepare for and respond to animal disease outbreaks.
