- 4. Any cattle within the shipment that are lactating, have been tested by PCR for influenza A virus, and have had negative results within 7 days of their expected return to Canada.
- 5. As far as can be determined, no captive birds or farmed mammals on any premises where these Canadian cattle have resided while in the United States, has had any serious contagious disease¹, to which cattle are susceptible, including highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI), during the preceding 60 days of their expected return to Canada.
- 6. All cattle within the shipment have been examined and deemed fit to be transported without undue suffering by reason of infirmity, illness, injury, fatigue or other cause during the expected journey, until unloading at the final destination.
- 7. Any transport vehicles or containers, in which the animals will be loaded, will be cleaned and disinfected before loading.
- 1. CFIA approved tests for brucella in cattle include Buffered Plate Agglutination Test (analogous to BAPA (Buffered Acidified Plate Antigen) used in the US); Enzyme-Linked Immunosorbent Assay; and Fluorescence Polarization Assay.
